This ADDENDUM has been issued to all Bidders in order to clarify contract document intent.

The following clarifications are issued in response to questions submitted at or subsequent to the August 4, 2010 pre-bid meeting.

Question 1:

There are no quantities listed on the pricing pages, but the bid bond asks for a specific dollar amount.

ANSWER 1:

The bid bond will be different for each Schedule. The contract will be based on a bid bond for each Schedule they bid.

Schedule A - add all unit prices and provide a 5% bid bond of the total.

Schedule B - add all unit prices and provide a 5% bid bond of the total.

Schedule C - 5% of total on Sheet C21 of 50 (1a, 1b, 1c, 1d & 2).

Schedule D - 5% of Paving Overlay of 15,000-sy X unit price for 1½" overlay (Item 3).

Schedule E - 5% of Double Micro-Surfacing of 7,500-sy X unit price (Item 2).

Question 2:

On the bottom of page C21 (Cost Proposal) of Schedule C: Disaster Recovery-Vegetative & Storm Debris Removal, it lists TOTAL ESTIMATED COSTS ITEM 1a, 1b, 1c, & 2. Are we to exclude item 1d in this total or was this a typing error?

ANSWER 2:

Please add item 1d to the Total Estimated Costs Item at the bottom page C21.

Question 3:

Schedule C: Disaster Recovery- Vegetative & Storm Debris Removal. On page C21 of 50 it states that ** Town to pay additional tipping fees to Martin County Landfill. Will the Town be responsible for all of landfill tipping fees or only if there are additional tipping fees?

ANSWER 3:

The Town will pay for all Martin County tipping fees directly to Martin County for the use of their land fill.

Question 4:

We are bidding Schedule E: Micro-Surfacing / Crack Sealant. The 7E Bid Proposal asks for unit prices only with no quantities or extensions. What do we enter for the Grand Total, just the sum of the unit prices? Also, on what contract amount do we base our 5% bid security?


